As your unit charters, the San Gabriel Valley Council requires that you also purchase an accident insurance policy. The council has made a group purchase and has included all the units in the council as part of this council policy. As a result your pack, troop team, or crew will purchase accident insurance with the council at a very low rate. **When you submit your charter for renewal or apply for a new charter, fill out the form below and return it with your charter.** You may include the premium amount with your charter fees in one check if you wish or you may submit a separate check. The check should be payable to the San Gabriel Valley Council, BSA.

This insurance plan provides for accident medical insurance, and a dental provision in the policy that provide coverage up to the limits of the policy. The Council accident & medical insurance policy provides primary coverage to the limits of the policy, unless there is other coverage that would pay on the claim. If there is any other insurance that is available to the youth or adult, like their family medical insurance, that insurance could be used to supplement the BSA coverage. The BSA policy is intended to contribute if no other policy exists or as the various insurance companies agree to work out payment of benefits. The insured person is covered while participating in sponsored and supervised functions and activities of the units and the council. This includes all the council summer camps and day camps. There are standard exclusions, the same as in most policies. Specific questions are explained on the claim form and information sheet that is distributed at the first of the year.

Units will pay their insurance fee at the time of charter renewal. Here is the rate for both the youth and adult members.

Pack: \$ .90	Troop: \$1.80
Team: \$1.80	Crew: \$2.40

Units pay a one-time fee, based on the number of youth and adults registered on the new charter. Additional youth and adults who register during the year are covered automatically, without any additional premium.

***\*All registered youth and adults in the council are included in this policy except for those units chartered to the Church of Jesus Christ of the Latter Day Saints and the Council's Learning for Life units.***
