The City of Claremont will host the Stage 7 Start for the Amgen Tour of California on Saturday, May 21, 2011.

The largest cycling event in America, the 2011 Amgen Tour of California is a Tour de France style cycling road race presented by AEG that challenges the world's top professional cycling teams to compete along a demanding course from May 15-22, 2011.

The Stage 7 leg of the race will start in front of the Claremont Depot on First Street before winding its way up to Mt. Baldy for a thrilling mountain top finish.

Professional riders will be available for autographs in the morning and festivities will continue throughout the day in the Village.

Amateur cyclists will ride the official **Amgen Tour of California race route** beginning at 7:00 a.m. This grueling ride will test even the most avid cyclist. Cyclists will ride over 75 miles and climb 10,000 feet up the winding roads of Mt. Baldy. The community is invited to cheer on the riders as they return beginning at noon in front of the Depot. Live bands will play all afternoon.
